The challenge we face

- The reality is we have a responsibility for two fundamental necessities:
 - 200,000+ miles of local roads
 - 3 million miles of utility networks beneath those roads
- Key assets in one physical space that is responsible for delivering modern day living heat/health/communication – mobility

 As custodians of these key national assets we have a joint responsibility to ensure their maintenance, upgrade and extension is managed in the most affective way for the users



The challenge we face

 An unprecedented investment programme that totals *£48 billion over the next 5 years has to be delivered against the forecast of increasing population, thought to rise to 76 million by 2047 in the UK, and a projected 43% increase in traffic





 This is the challenge that faces us, we must ensure that the programme is delivered to time, budget and with minimum disruption
