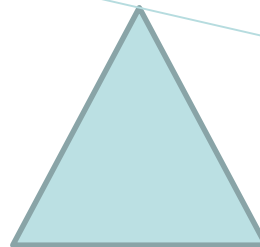

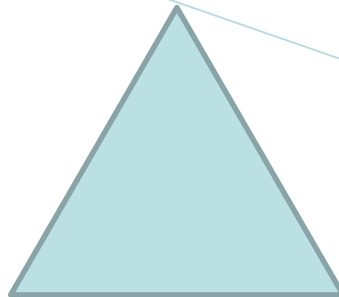

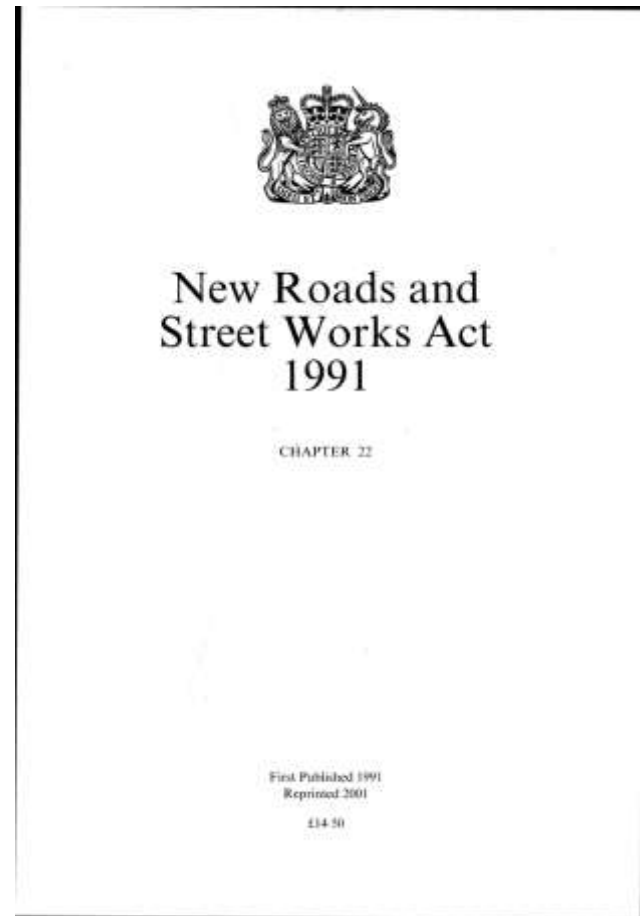

NRSA (1991)

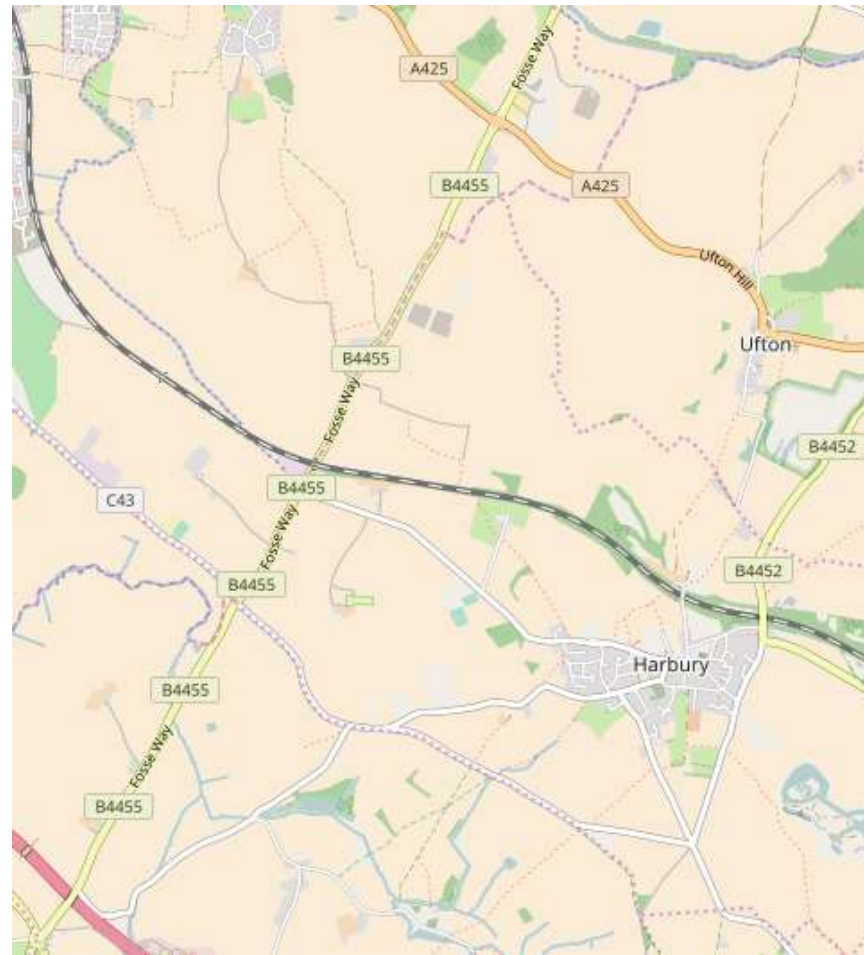
- **New Roads and Street Works Act (1991)**
- Section 59 places a duty on highway authorities to co-ordinate works on the highway.
- Equally important is the parallel duty on undertakers (utility companies) to co-operate in this process under Section 60.



Case Study

- Network Rail, Fosseway Warwickshire
- Brickwork and Parapet renewals, original request for 25 week closure.
- Agreed 10 week one way order.
- Local employer Jaguar, Landrover with 7500 employees on the one site at Gaydon.

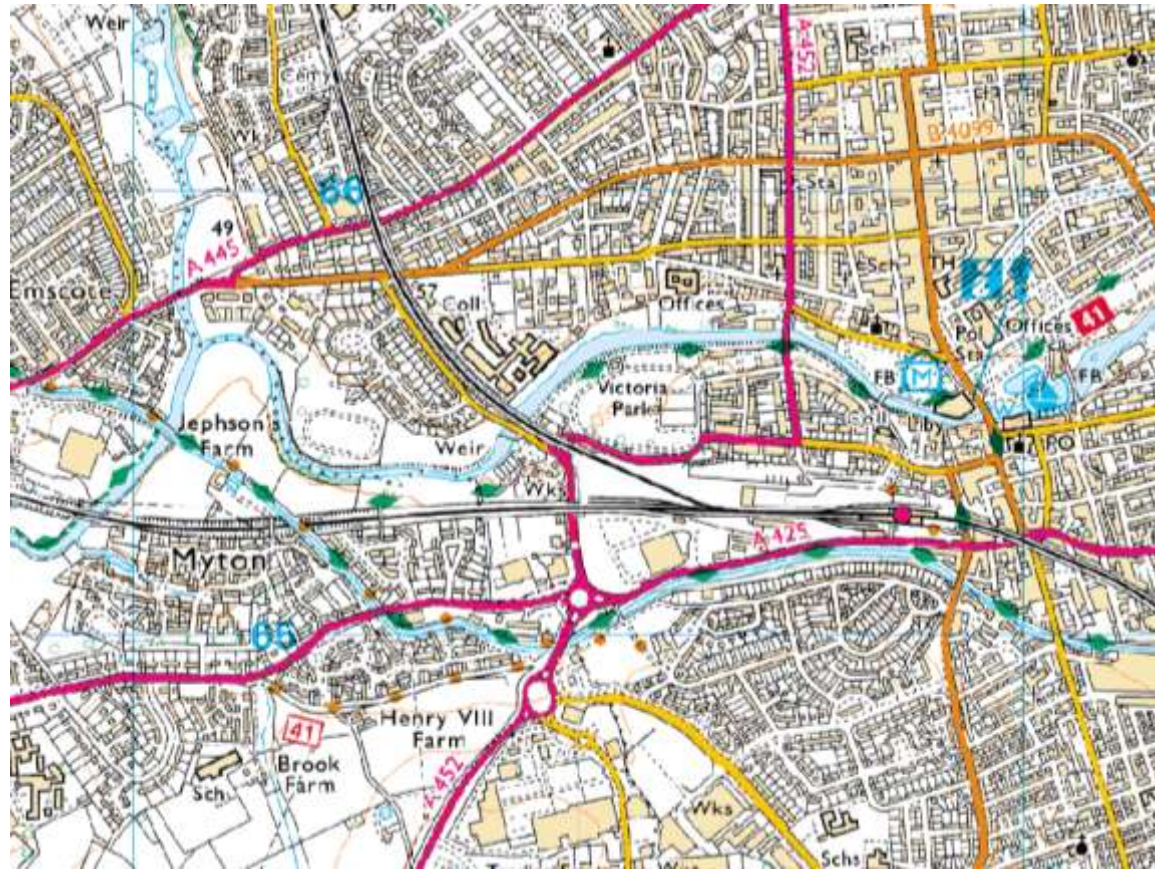

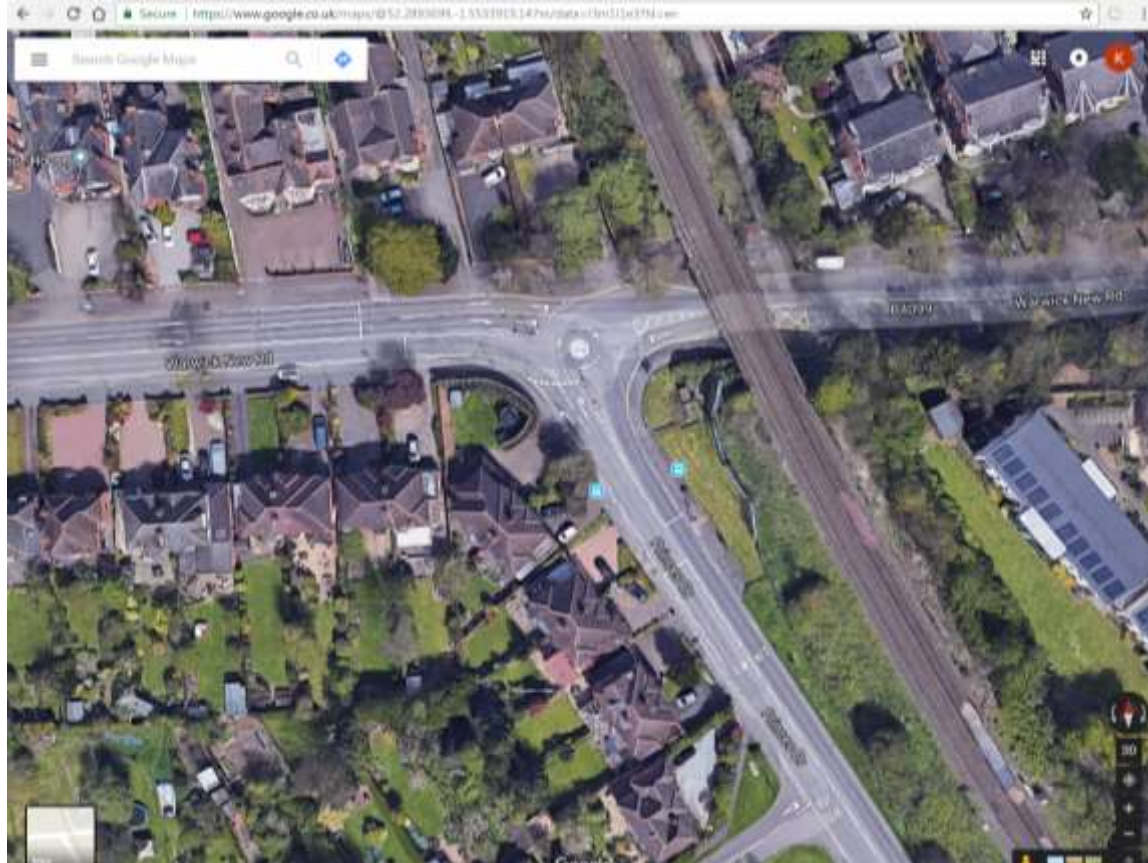

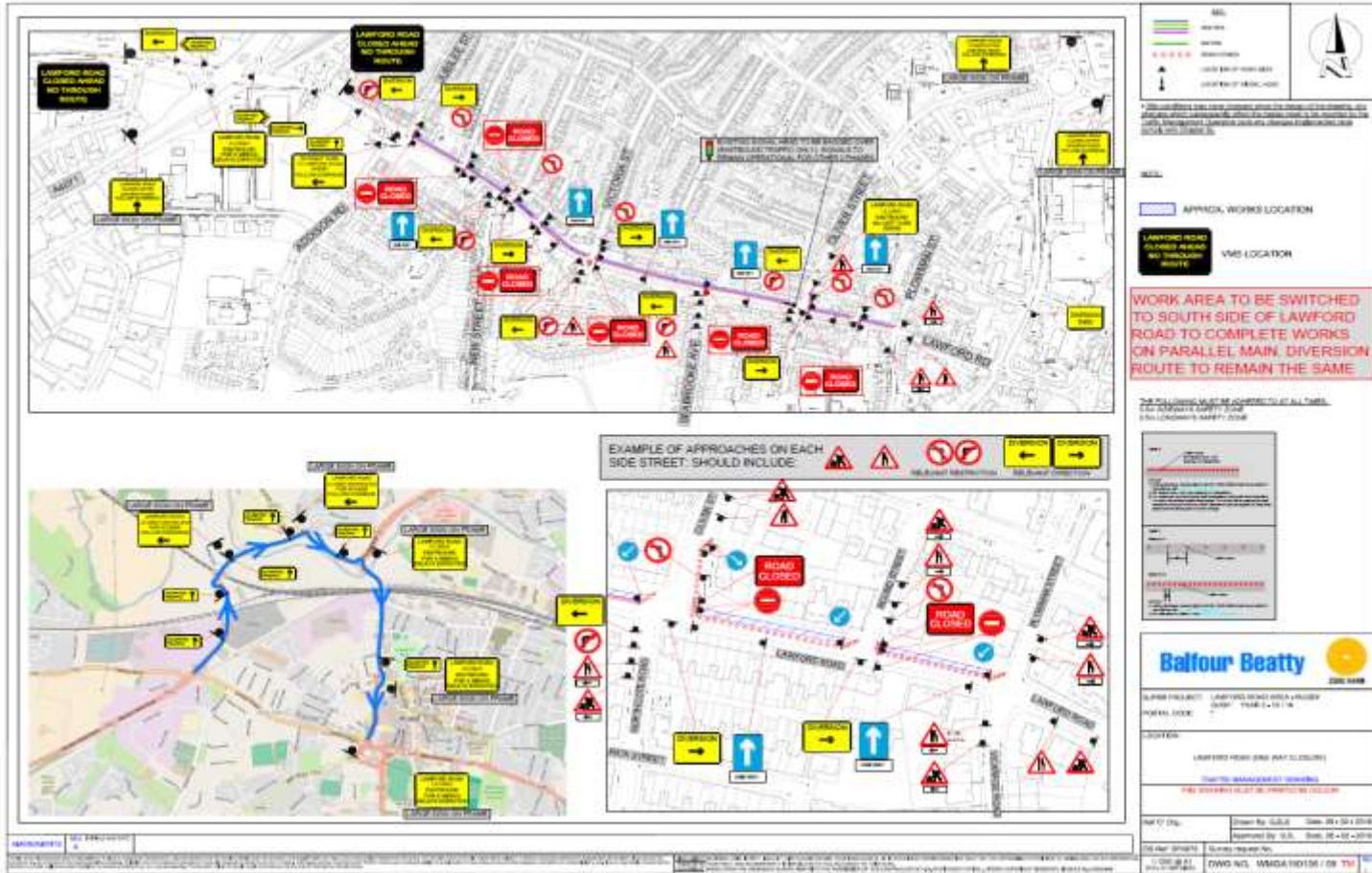


Excavation took out a lane and restricted the width under the bridge.
